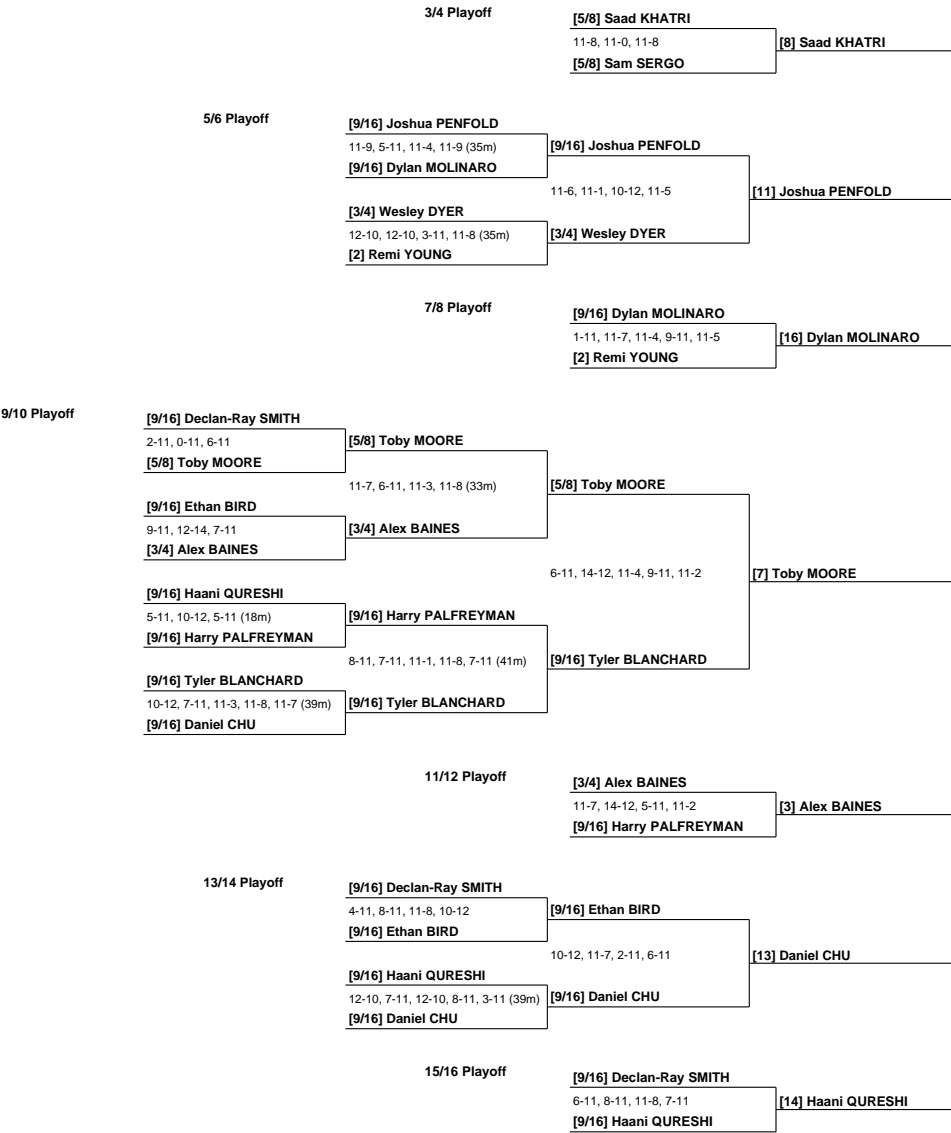


**Main Draw**
